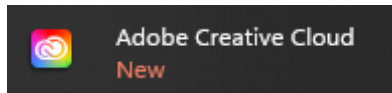


Signing into and downloading Adobe applications

Opening Adobe Creative Cloud

1. Windows

Open the **Start Menu**. Search for **Adobe** and open **Adobe Creative Cloud**.



Mac

EITHER Open the Adobe Creative Cloud app from either the Applications folder or the Launchpad

OR Open Spotlight (keyboard shortcut [Command ⌘] + [SPACE]) then search for Adobe Creative Cloud and select the relevant application search result

If you don't have Adobe Creative Cloud installed on your computer

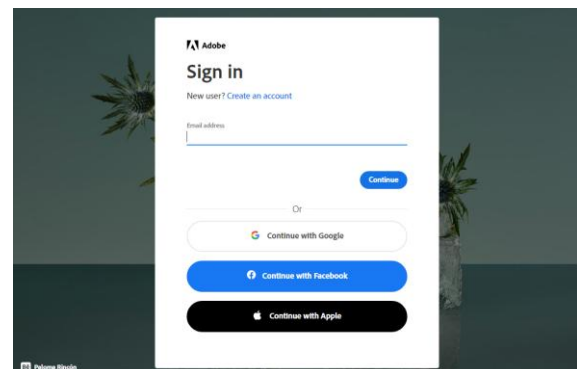

Signing into Adobe Creative Cloud

- In the **Email address** field, type your Departmental e-mail address and then click **Continue**

IMPORTANT: Do not click on the Continue with Google, Facebook, or Apple buttons

E-mail addresses are in the format of **Firstname.LastnameX@schools.sa.edu.au**, where X is a random number generated between 0 and 999



- If prompted to login to EdPass**

Students:

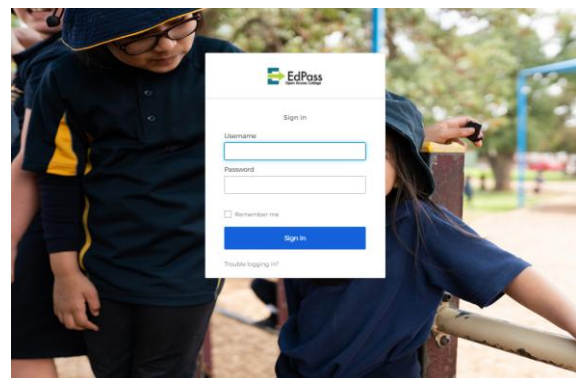
Username: Your Student ID number

Password: Date of birth
(YYYYMMDD format)

Staff:

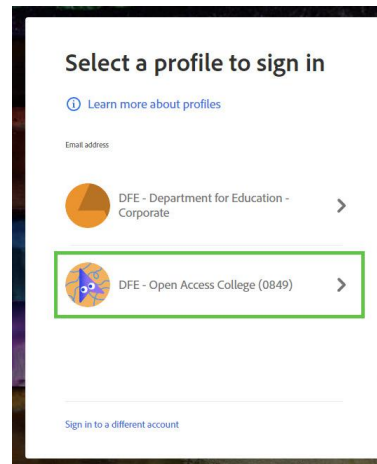
Username: First 4 letters of your last name followed by the first 2 letters of your first name
(some exceptions apply)

Password: Your password to access computers and the Intranet

4. If prompted to select a profile, select **DFE – Open Access College (0849)**



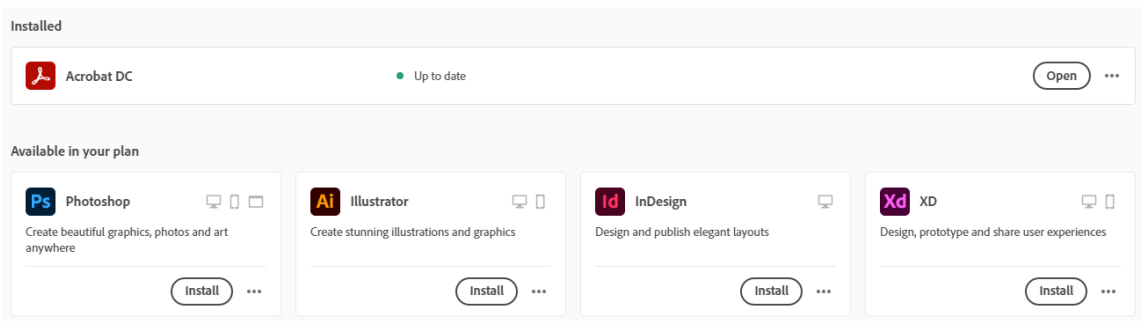
Downloading applications
