Sports Administrator: Manage clubs, promote their sport, obtain corporate sponsorship and refine the rules and structure of the game.

Sports Coach: Teach individuals and teams how to improve the way they play by analysing their performances, instructing them in skills, and providing motivation.

Sports Development Officer: Promote sports and coordinate the participation of people in sport, including special interest groups.

Do you play sport? Do you think it's useful for school study and your career?


The <u>Year13 Play On Youth Sports Initiative</u> survey found that of the young people who play sport the majority believe it benefits their studies because it helps:


