Direct Entry Pathways
to Flinders University



Open Access College + Flinders University Partnership

Open Access College and Flinders University have partnered to offer eligible students a direct entry pathway to university. This pathway is available to Open Access College students undertaking specific VET courses in combination with SACE subjects. Pathways include Computing/IT, Creative Industries/Arts, Education/Teaching, Engineering, Health, and Science.

Entry Requirements

- SACE Completion
- Successful completion of a specific VET course in Year 11/12
- Successful completion of specific Stage 2 subjects (see table for minimum grade requirements)
- Any additional course specific requirements as listed on the relevant course webpage (e.g. subject pre-requisites, audition, portfolio, etc) will also need to be met

Offers

Students apply through SATAC and Open Access College will inform Flinders University of students eligible for the program. Students receive an offer via SATAC in January once all of the entry requirements have been met and confirmed.
