Program Information and How to Enrol

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

In 2022, free one-to-one online maths tutoring is available for South Australian students in Year 6 to Year 9 as part of the Department for Education's Learning+ program.

Your child is invited to receive free tutoring in this exciting initiative.

What is Learning+?

The Department for Education launched the Learning+ pilot program last year, inviting students in Year 6 and Year 8 from over 80 schools to participate in online mathematics tutoring. With the success of the pilot program, Learning+ has been expanded to include students in Year 6 to Year 9 in 2022.

How does it work?

The program is designed for students of all mathematical abilities, as it is individually tailored to each student's learning needs, to support their academic growth and independent learning.

Students will be allocated a tutor, who is a qualified teacher with experience teaching mathematics and an in-depth understanding of the Australian Curriculum, and will participate in online tutoring for 30 minutes, twice a week for 10 weeks, after school and/or on weekends.

How can my child participate?

Our school nominated to participate in the Learning+ program in 2022 and students in years 7 and 8 has been selected to take part in Term 2, 2022.

Places are limited and once tutoring spots are filled, students will be placed on a waitlist for Term 3.

16 Mar to 23 Mar 2022	Tutor booking system open for Term 2 enrolments
Week 7, Term 1	The booking system will be open to all parents for a short period of time, get in quick to secure your preferred days and times.
	Learning+ will notify parents when the Term 2 booking system is open via email and text message.
11 Apr 2022	Student – Tutor allocations confirmed
Week 11, Term 1	Learning+ will provide email confirmation to both student and parent of tutor allocation and tutoring session details.
11 Apr 2022	Student welcome
Week 11, Term 1	Learning+ will provide students with information & resources on the program.
2 May 2022	Term 2 tutoring program commences
Week 1, Term 2	Students will begin tutoring sessions this week with their tutors.
