


How to make an account in Moodle - students

1. You can find the link to Moodle on the OAC web site <http://www.openaccess.edu.au/students> or you can use the direct link to Moodle logon screen by going to <http://moodle.openaccess.edu.au/>

It is suggested that you add this URL (web address) to your Favourites/Bookmarks.

If you set yourself up as a Moodle user last year, you do not have to do it again.

2. To create a new account, click **Create new account** and follow the on-screen instructions. You will then be sent an email with a link back to Moodle.



4. To use the enrolment key, find the course category that is relevant to you (eg. Early/Primary Years R-7)



5. Click on the subject name and enter the enrolment key. The course home page will be displayed. The next time you log in to OAC Moodle the subject will appear under the heading My Home in the lefthand block. If you have any problems, contact your teacher.
