What are we offering?

- 10 SACE credits through completing Introduction to Construction, Plumbing and Roof Plumbing with PEER VEET (RTO code: 45744) including the following nationally recognised units
 - CPCCOM1013 Plan and organise work
 - CPCCVE1011 Undertake a basic construction project
 - CPCCWHS2001 Apply WHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry
- White card
- 1 week's work experience hosted with a TAPS host employer
- Non accredited KESAB and Mates in Construction Life Skills Tool Box workshops *
- A PPE pack (hard hat, earmuffs, safety specs, gloves, glove clip, backpack and Hi-Viz shirt)*

Employment criteria

- Complete the Plumbing and Roof Plumbing Job Skills program
- Have a car and driver's license or close to getting one
- Available to work a minimum of 3 days per week (school based) OR
- Available to work 38 hours per week (full time)
- Complete a Premedical, Aptitude and VETRO assessments
- Motivation to complete the Certificate III in Plumbing or the Certificate III in Roof Plumbing and your SACE

What you need to do

1. Express your interest by sending your resume, cover letter and completing the online EOI
2. Attend the information session at TAPS
3. Complete an interview and pre-medical with TAPS. You will then be provided advice whether you have been successful in gaining a position in the program
4. If successful in gaining a position you are required to attend an enrolment session at PEER to complete enrolment paperwork, register for a CITB number and complete your Workplace Learning Agreement forms
5. Commence Job Skills program Monday 18th November (see program schedule).
6. Complete Job Skills program 13th December (including 1 week's work experience).
7. Undertake merit-based selection process with TAPS and host employer.
8. If successful, negotiate school-based or full-time apprenticeship.
9. Commence apprenticeship.
