After your enrolment... what's next?

Here are some hints to guide you through the process from signing your enrolment form to your first class.

- Once all required paperwork has been received, your information will be entered onto the Open Access College database.
- You will be emailed a 'Confirmation of Enrolment'. This letter will include your OAC Student ID number which you will need to access Daymap. You can also use this letter to confirm your enrolment with Centrelink.
- Please check all details carefully and let the Student Services team know if there are any errors in your personal details or subjects selected.
- You will be allocated a timetable shortly thereafter.
 Contact your Student Wellbeing Leader if you have any questions about this.
- Once your timetable is in place, your teachers will contact
 you by phone or EdPass email to let you know your lesson times
 and how to access your lessons. You will be allocated an EdPass
 email if you don't already have one.
- Ensure that the phone number you provided is correct. Please contact Student Services with any changes to your details.
