What does a Tiling Apprentice do?

As a Tiling Apprentice you will lay ceramic, clay, slate, marble, glass and other types of tiles on external and internal walls and floors to provide protective and decorative finishes. You may also:

- Plan and organise work
- Carry out measurements and calculations
- Apply basic levelling procedures
- Read and interpret plans and specifications
- Handle wall and floor tiling materials
- Use wall and floor tiling tools and equipment
- Prepare surfaces for tiling application
- Fix wall and floor tiles
- Repair wall and floor tiles
- Carry out mosaic tiling
- Apply waterproofing process to internal wet areas.

Apprentice Requirements:

To be considered for a Tiling Apprenticeship the following is required:

- A willingness to develop skills and knowledge in this trade
- Physical fitness and the ability to undertake manual labour for extended periods
- Be a safe confident worker
- Willingness to travel
- White Card (or be willing to obtain prior to starting)
- Enjoy practical and manual work
- Ability to follow instructions and communicate effectively
- MUST have a car and licence, is required due to changing sites.
