Program Overview

This program is delivered over 4 days (24 hours). The program focuses on trade careers within the construction industry and provides students with practical activities in carpentry, bricklaying, plumbing, tiling, sheeting and flushing and demolition. This includes:

- Safety induction training (Obtainment of White Card) CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to Work Safely in the Construction Industry.
- Excursion to visit a live construction site and explore scope of works. SYC Building Links project in partnership with South Australian Housing Authority.
- Hands on activities to experience roles including Carpentry, Plumbing, Bricklaying, Sheeting & Flushing, Tiling and Demolition.

We provide students with practical skill knowledge building activities to provide exposure to actual workplace tasks. This includes:

- Drafting and planning construction projects
- Building framework to meet project scope
- Bricking framework to build wall structures
- Integration of plumbing system within wall structure
- · Sheeting and flushing wall surfaces
- Tiling and grouting

Although this program includes (Obtainment of White Card) CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to Work Safely in the Construction Industry, the remainder of the program is non-accredited.

Course Requirements

All students registered and attending this course will need to wear steel capped boots from day 2 through to 4.

Program Outcome

On successful completion of this course, students will receive a statement of attainment for CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry, a White Card, and Certificate of Participation and Completion for the program.
