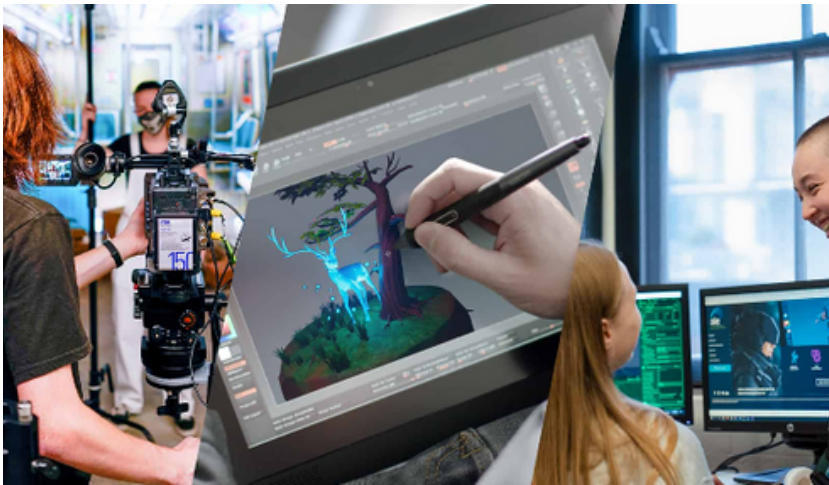

Occupations	<u>General Practitioner (GP)</u> , <u>Specialist Practitioner</u> .	<u>Medical Laboratory Technician</u> , <u>Biomedical scientist</u> .
Daily work	Direct patient care and treatment.	Conducting experiments in labs.
Suits	Individuals who thrive under pressure, possess strong communication skills, and enjoy hands-on care.	Individuals interested in research, analytical thinking, and problem-solving.
Pathway	A medical degree and clinical training.	A biomedical science degree.

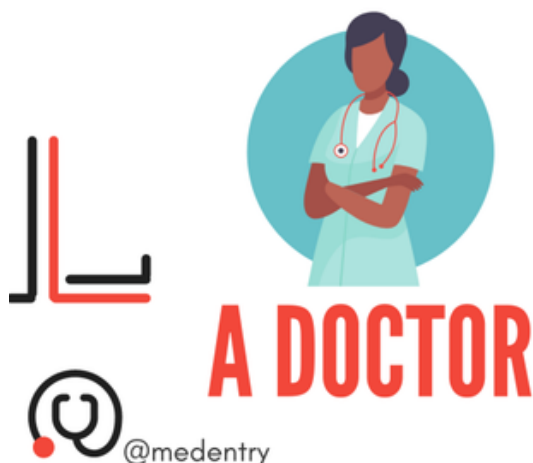

Collarts invites budding young creatives to enter their annual design competition, with the chance to win prizes to help you make your creative dream a reality.

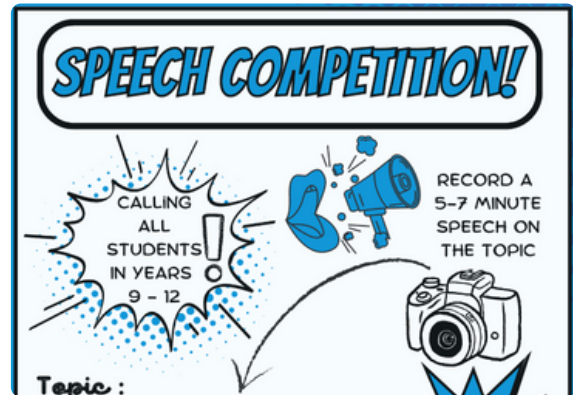
